Geneological sketch of a part of the Jayne family. The progenitor of the Jayne family in the United States was William Jayne, born at Bristol, England Jan 25. 1618. He was a clergyman, and as I am informed, a Professor in the University at Oxford. At the time he emigrated, owing to religious disturbances, to this country in 1678, he was 60 years of age, and a widower: leaving three sons in England. He settled at Smith town Long Island N. Y. as pastor of the Puritan church in that place, which position he retained until he died March 24th 1714 aged 96. In 1682 he married Anna Briggs, by whom he had seven sons, William, born March 1684; Samuel, Matthias, John, Daniel, James and Stephen; the latter born in the year 1700, his father being in his 82 year.

(There may be some doubt as to the order of birth of the 3d, 4th and 5th, as I have not the dates.)

William, Matthias, John and Stephen were freeholders in that town in 1757. Samuel and Daniel sold out on Long Island in 1726; Samuel to Stephen and Daniel to Matthias. William died in 1735 aged 51; Samuel in 1765, Daniel in 1781, James in 1785 and Stephen in 1784. No dates of the death of Matthias and John are on record. All were yeomen or landowners. B. G. Jayne wrote further Aug 5. 1882. "I am in possession of copies of the rolls of four of the original brothers

Samuel, Daniel, James and Stephen. By there I find that Samuel left one son, Daniel no sons, James six sons and Stephen, five. William left four sons. The descendents of Stephen Jayne, who was of the same generation as ourselves, the 6th, lives on the old place or homestead where William settled in 1678.

William Jayne was born as before stated in 1684, married Anna Sterling in 1709 and by her had four sons and a number of daughters: William born April 12, 1712, Samuel born December 1713, Isaac, born November 1715; Joseph born in 1727. "of the number and ages of the daughters I have no record" says Benajah Jayne "I remember my grandfather telling me when he was a little boy of his Aunt Katurah Brewster, who was his father's sister and of an Aunt Annie also."

From this and other sources I (E. C. J.) was informed that Katurah Jayne married the younger of the two "Elder" Brewsters of Connecticut, the progenitors of the Brewsters of this city, ~~Mass~~ (Philadelphia). Samuel Jayne settled at Florida, Orange County N.Y. where he died in 1779, aged 66 leaving one son Samuel and an unmarried daughter Mary and wife Dinah. Isaac moved to Vermont and left five sons and at least one daughter Anna, who married her cousin Isaac. Joseph remained on Long Island and married Abigail Strong by whom he raised ten

daughters and four sons. The old bible gives the dates of their births.

William Jayne, born as before stated in 1712. In 1733 he married Tabitha Norton who was born at Brookhaven Long Island in 1713. By her he raised six sons and three daughters. Their children were, William born in 1735, and killed at the battle of Fort Mifflin, Nov 16, 1776, Anna born in 1737; married Benajah Gustin and died in 1821, aged 84. Tabitha, born in 1779, married Richard Horton and died in 1820. Captain Snoddy born April 15, 1741, married Sarah Allen, and died January 20 1809. Betsy, (Elizabeth) born in 1743 married Thomas Owen, no record of death. Isaac, born Nov 26 1746, married his cousin Anna Jayne and died January 12 1809. John, born Dec 25 1748, married Cornelia Decker and died April 25th 1838. David (Reverend) born May 14, 1751 married Elizabeth De Witt and died March 9 1857. Ebenezer (Reverend) born February 19, 1754 and married, first Elizabeth Riggs and second Mary De Witt, dying March 27, 1826 aged 72. In 1755 William Jayne together with his brother Samuel removed from Long Island to Blooming Grove Orange County N.Y. where Ebenezer his youngest child was born: the others having been born on Long Island. In 1756 he (William) moved to what was then Smithfield, Northampton Co (now ^{at} Colchester)

(now Coolbaugh), Monroe Co Pa.

B. G. Jayne writes in addition to the above "our great grandfather, William Jayne, left nine children six sons and three daughters. The six sons left forty six children. Of these 25 were sons and twenty one were daughters. Eighteen of these twenty five sons, now traced have sixty sons who have families and there are a number of these ^{sixty} sons who have great grand children. You will see by this that the tribe of Jayne has become quite numerous.

Verbally he (Benajah) informed me that he had traced eight thousand of the name, not counting the female branches whose name had changed to others, who had sprung from the single pair, William, and Anna Briggs Jayne, since 1684.

The De Witts were from Holland, and were I understand Cousins of De Witt Clinton of N. Y. There is no question that they were of the same family as John and Cornelius De Witt of Holland. He William d. in 1798 at the age of 86, and his (E. C. J.) widow in 1808 aged 95.

Of the families of these Susan White Pieroth 2012

1st William

He had one son, born Nov 16, 1758 wounded at the assault on Fort Mifflin, and died from the effects of his wound a few months later.

He had also two daughters Anna and Tabitha born

1756 and 1760. They married two brothers Benajah and Chambus Pennell, and left large families. William left no descendants bearing his name.

2nd Anna

married Benajah Gustin but left no children.

3d Sabitha.

Left two sons at least (her husband Richard Horton) and died in 1820, near the old home at Middle Smithfield.

4th Captain Timothy.

He left six sons and four daughters who raised families as follows. 1st Anna born in 1764, married David Ogden and by him raised four children.

She then married Aaron Van Houton, and died in 1838 at Utica New York, aged 75.

Her descendants are very numerous. 2d David Jayne born 1768 married Polly Barry, and by her had fourteen children two, William and Julia are still living (1882) at Eton Pa. He died in 1858 aged 90 years.

3d William born 1772 married Elizabeth Bunnell and by her raised eleven children, nine of whom are still living (1882) in Wyoming Co Pa. William died in 1855 aged 61.

4th John Jayne born in 1778 married first Agnes Packer and second Mary Bunnell, by the former he had one son and one daughter, both of whom are dead, and by the latter three sons, all living in 1882.

John died in 1835 aged 62. 5th Ebenezer Jayne

born in 1775, of whom there is no record save that he was a soldier in the War of 1812.

6th - Trinity Jayne born in 1777, lived and raised a large family in Western Pennsylvania near Pittsburg. Her son Alexander, a fruitier and afterward a tea merchant, was a very prominent and excellent man and Mayor of Pittsburg, dying of cholera in 1854. He left three sons and 1 (E. G. J.) think two daughters. 7th - Rebecca Jayne born in 1779 and married William Roe a Baptist preacher. They had two children, a boy Peter and a girl Rebecca - no further record.

8th - Daniel Jayne born in 1785^(probably wrong year), moved to Indiana was still living in 1850, and after which no further record. 9th - Sarah Jayne born in 1783 married James Decker. She was "a charming old lady" says Benajah Jayne, but gives no further record. 10th - Elija C. Jayne, born in 1785, married John White and died in 1855 leaving five daughters of whom have no record.

5th - "Petsy" Elisabeth Jayne married Thomas Owen - no further record.

6th - Isaac Jayne

He left four sons and three daughters, three dying unmarried. Those leaving families were 1st.

Sabitha Jayne born in 1770 married Richard Horton jr and died in Bradford Co Pa in 1840 "a full record of this family promised" says B. G. J.

2d Abram Jayne born in 1775, married Julia Bayberry and raised five children, two sons and three daughters. all living in 1882 except "the late Judge William S. Jayne" of Bradford Co Pa. Abram died in 1856 aged 81. 3d - Sarah Jayne, born in 1778 and married George Labar. She left nine children four of whom were still living in 1882. She died in 1864 aged 86.

Note: Eben L. Jayne, the compiler of this record compiled by Ebeniah G. Jayne was on terms of warm friendship with Judge Henry Labar of Bushkill Pa. whom he visited in 1865 and George Labar, as well, both sons of Sarah Jayne. Judge Labar was married but had no children. He was a very bright intelligent and excellent man: universally respected and esteemed and of wide influence in his section.

His wife was a general pleasant woman; and a visit to their hospitable home was always a real pleasure as were theirs in return, to my home in Philadelphia.

It was owing to the warm friendship existing between between Judge Labar and Dr David Jayne of Philadelphia that caused the latter - they were second cousins - to name his third son after him. "Henry LaBarre Jayne" - The latter is a prominent lawyer of Philadelphia. 4th - Isaac Jayne born in 1780.

married Sallie Ogan. Isaac was a near neighbor and friend of Joshua R. Giddings. He noted John Cautherspit + Abolitionist in Ohio. He left several sons

and daughters, but have no further record. Isaac died in 1852. 3th - Daniel Jayne born in 1784, married Mary Shoemaker, by whom he had five children, four daughters and one son. One of the daughters, Blandina married — Adams and removed to Wisconsin. The son Julius and other daughter died unmarried. Daniel was posthonorary of Monroe Co for many years. 6th - Peter Jayne born in 1787, married Mary Bush, by whom he had nine children, four sons and five daughters. One son and three daughters were still living in 1882. Peter died in 1855. 7th - Elizabeth Jayne born in 1792, married Phillip Riggs. Moved to Ashland Co., Ohio. no further record.

7th: John Jayne.

He left seven children, Sabatha Jayne, born in 1778, married John Dutcher, and by him had six sons all of whom paired families. Two were still living in 1882. 1st Tabitha Jayne died in 1842.

2d Hannah Jayne, born in 1778, married Thomas Bunnell, and by him had two sons and a daughter. The sons are dead, and the daughter was still living in 1882 aged 80. Hannah died in 1838.

3d Henry Jayne, born in 1783, married Catharine Crawford, and by her raised eleven children four sons and seven daughters. Two of the daughters were still living in 1882. The widow died in the latter year aged 97. 4th - Anna Jayne, born in

1787 married John Ogden, and died in 1837, leaving no children. 5th- Benaiah Jayne, father of the compiler B. G. Jayne - born 1790, married first Rhoda Case and second Mary Whitaker, by the first he had one daughter, and by the second six sons and three daughters. Five sons and three daughters were still living in 1882. 8th- David Jayne born in 1793, married Phoebe Daily, and by her had two sons and two daughters. B. G. J. says "Uncle David was County Judge of Loga County at the time of his death in 1840." 7th- Abba Jayne, born in 1797 married Matthew Crawford, and by him had three sons and five daughters. She died in February in 1882 aged 85 years.

8th- David Jayne

Married Elizabeth DeWitt, (sister to my (E. G. J.'s) grandmother - two brothers marrying two sisters) by whom he had fourteen children, ten boys and four girls. Four of the boys died in childhood. Six boys and four girls raised families as follows:
 1st Samuel Jayne born in 1779 married Elsie Stephens and died in 1853 leaving four sons and seven daughters. Three sons and three daughters were still living in 1882 the eldest Ebenezer aged 82.
 2d Benaiah Jayne, born in 1781 and married Elizabeth Carter. He had but one child and died in 1862 in his 82d year. His son was born in 1809

and died in the spring of 1882 aged 75 years, leaving fourteen children and many grandchildren

3d Mary D. Jayne born in 1783, married Amos Miller and left nine children eight of whom were living in 1882. She died in 1854 aged 71.

4th - David Jayne born in 1785 married Margaret Ogden and left five sons and two daughters. The five sons and one daughter were living in 1882. ~~She~~

~~was~~ 5th - Ebenezer Jayne born in 1787. He lived in Kentucky, near Cincinnati Ohio and of whom no further record.

6th - Tabitha Jayne born in 1789 married her cousin Timothy Horton Jr, and was living in Cincinnati in 1862.

7th Sarah Jayne born in 1793 married Abrah Miller and by him had four sons and four daughters, all living in 1882 - she died in 1863.

8th Elizabeth Jayne born in 1794, married a man named Punch, no further record than that she had a daughter living in Cincinnati in 1882

9th Timothy Jayne born in 1796, married first Lucy Kent and second Phoebe Plympton, had four sons and four daughters by the first wife and one son and two daughters by the second. All the sons and two daughters by the first wife and one son and two daughters by the second were living in 1882. He died in 1869

10th - William Jayne born in 1799. He left four sons and four daughters. No further record.

Note - Elder or the Rev David Jayne was a noted

Baptist minister and according to verbal information received was the means of establishing most of the Baptist Churches of his time in northern Pennsylvania and Western New York. He was a man of ability a fine speaker, possessed of much executive ability and energy and was universally esteemed.

9th Rev. Ebenezer Jayne

Born as stated Feb 19. 1754. Like his brother David he was a noted Baptist minister; his field of labor lying mainly in New Jersey, itinerating, and as pastor of several churches mostly in the southern part of the State. He was universally esteemed (we may say beloved) and a welcome guest in almost every house in which in the course of his itineracy, he visited. He was a noted controversialist in the narrow sectarianism of his time, and also a writer of many hymns, published in book form but which were not of the highest order of merit. He died on the 27th of May 1826 at Canton N.J. while pastor of the church at that place, and his interment, together with his second wife and some of his children in the graveyard attached to that church, aged at the time of his death 72 years. He married first Elizabeth Riggs March 25. 1781, and second Mary De Witt, daughter of Isaac and Mary DeWitt born June 7. 1766 and died April 2. 1826. By the first wife he had one son, Timothy, born Feb 21

office of Dr Drayton, attended the medical courses in the University of Penn and commenced the practice of medicine in 1825 in Cape May Co. N.J. In 1831 he placed on sale the first of his Proprietary medicine, following it up at intervals by others. In 1836 he removed to Phila. purchasing the drug store No 20. So 3d St., entered into practice and at the same time extended his sales. By his untiring energy and perseverance his business grew - soon (in 1848) he commenced the erection of his 8 story granite store house (then 84 Chestnut St) now No 242 - 244.

At the time of its erection it was the largest and finest building of its kind in the United States. He afterward erected many other stores and in 1866 his marble mansion corner of 19 and Chestnut streets which he did not live to enter. He was a man of extraordinary force of character far seeing - well informed and well read. of a generous and charitable disposition, and a fast friend. in politics an earnest Republican and in religious faith a life long Baptist. He possessed the confidence and esteem of the community - died Mar 5. 1866. left a very large fortune. Is buried in his family lot in Woodlands Cemetery West Phila where rest also the remains of his two first two wives, ~~both~~ together with those of Matilda, De Witt, and others of his children
