Pulaski Carter
died with out a will.

That he will, as the administrator well and truly administer the
goods and chattels, rights, and credits of said deceased, according to law.

That he will immediately publish for creditors, once a week for six successive weeks, and
render into the Register's-Office, within thirty days from this date, a just and true inventory and appraisement
of the personal estate of said deceased, and additional inventories when necessary. Also a just and true ac-
count, calculation, and reckoning of his said administration in one year from this date, or when there-
unto legally required. That he will diligently and faithfully regard, and well and truly comply
with the provisions of law relating to collateral inheritances. And also that Pulaski Car-

ter, the deceased, died leaving to survive him
the following heirs, viz: his wife, Eliza D. Carter,
two sons, Pulaski P. Carter and Marvin P. Carter and one
daughter, Annelia M. Kennedy, all of age
